### 2007/08 - UNDER 17 - a11 Allievi "A"

#### **PARTICIPATION CATEGORY AND AGE LIMITS**

The Tournament is reserved for players belonging to the **UNDER 17 (2007/08)** category, regularly registered with the Federation for the current season, born between 1 January 2007 and up to the age of 14.

#### **DOUBLE TEAMS "A" and "B" – NO EXCHANGE OF PLAYERS**

In the event that a club registers TWO or more teams in the same category, it is **FORBIDDEN to exchange players from one team to another during the entire tournament**. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED. Before the start of the first match, the club will decide the squads of the various teams and a **colored bracelet will be given to be worn by the players**, under penalty of disqualification of the team. It is allowed to exchange players from one CATEGORY to another, if they are of regular age.

#### **LOANS**

A **maximum of n. 3 loans** of players not belonging to teams participating in the same tournament - upon presentation of the *Nulla Osta* of the club to which they belong - which must be delivered to the tournament secretariat before the start of the match in which it is intended to use these players.

#### **PLAYER LIST**

The participating clubs must submit to the organization of the tournament, before its start, the list of players who intend to use up to a **maximum of 25 players**. No changes can be made to these lists after delivery. Up to a **maximum of 18 players will be indicated in the list to be presented to the Match Director before the match**.

#### **REPLACEMENTS**

A maximum of **7 substitutions** are allowed, regardless of position/role, at any time during the match.

#### **CHARTS**

The rankings will be drawn up on the basis of the following criteria:

**3 points for a win - 1 point for a draw - 0 points for a loss.**
